Sustainability Initiatives

WindStar makes softening their carbon footprint a big priority. Many ships have installed advanced wastewater treatment systems and new engines, which will reduce emissions. These important changes aren't where sustainability initiatives end for WindStar. Onboard, chefs source food locally when possible and instead of large buffets, meals are prepared to order, which reduces waste. Another big trend is to reduce single-use plastics. Refillable Natura water bottles are placed in the cabins and refilling water stations are located throughout ships. Plastic straws and stir sticks are also not dispensed on board unless they are specially requested.


